





Dear Dr. Sharolli:

This letter serves as an introduction for a patient and her husband who I am referring to you for general dentistry needs. Amanda [REDACTED] came to our office from another general dentist approximately one year ago. She had conflicting recommendations regarding her periodontal care. She had a bridge placed in the maxillary anterior area, which she is not happy with. She wishes she had had implants placed instead.

On March 22, 2004, I performed connective tissue grafting for Amanda at the #22 to #28 area where she had significant recession, as well as no keratinized tissue remaining. I am happy to report that the results of this grafting have been quite pleasing. Amanda has asked us to remove the pontics on her new bridge in the maxillary anterior and place implants at sites #8 and #9. It is my understanding that we will be proceeding with this treatment in the not-too-distant future.

Amanda asked me to refer her to a high quality dentist in the Plano area and your name immediately came to mind. I know that she and her husband will do well under your care. It is always a pleasure to share with you in the treatment of mutual patients.
